CHALLENGE

High-Tech Under the Heat

The owners were looking to create a golfing experience that would allow beginner and professional players alike to see the game from a whole new angle and develop their skills like never before. Furthermore, they relied on Ford's expertise to provide high-quality outdoor displays that would provide a clear image without buckling under regular extreme temperature changes.

ACTION

The Next Step in Modern Golf

The project's main attraction features 60 bays of golf games spread out over three floors. Each bay features a 32" heads-up display that is close to the golfer, a 21.5" touchscreen interface and two 42" gallery displays – one for friends to watch the player's game screen and one to watch TV. A 200" diagonal, video wall and a 360-degree LED sports ticker are also visual centerpieces. All in all, there are more than 300 displays and 160 speakers supplying video and audio to 20 different zones via one central control system and a specially designed interface controlled by iPads.

RESULT

A Hole In One!

The principals of FlyingTee are ecstatic not only at the "wow" factor of the finished product, but also the ease with which the hundreds of pieces of new equipment could be controlled, automated, and synchronized. To pull it off, Ford designed a network infrastructure featuring OM4 fiber interconnects, Cisco switchgear and wireless access points.
