System Features

It is essential for the Williamson County ESOC to have technology that allows officials to effectively communicate during emergency operations.

- The 911 Call Center has wall-mounted displays for monitoring visual information necessary to operators receiving emergency calls, and audio distributed overhead
- The EOC, which serves as the primary meeting space in emergency situations, has a projection system, touchpanel control system, overhead audio for unified monitoring, and wireless mics for special announcements
- As the secondary meeting space, the EEOC includes a projection system, additional displays, touchpanel control system, and wireless mics
