Coors Field blends modern stadium comforts and amenities with the charm and nostalgia of a classic ballpark. It is constructed with hand-laid brick and has a signature clock tower atop its main entrance.

- The stadium uses 400 custom-designed, weatherproof loudspeakers distributed across seating areas, replacing the traditional central cluster to minimize noise spill into nearby neighborhoods while also providing discreet 2-channel stereo playback and integration with the life-safety announcement system.
- Over 160 amplifiers are managed through a centralized, computer system allowing operators to easily test, monitor, and control the entire audio setup from a single location.
